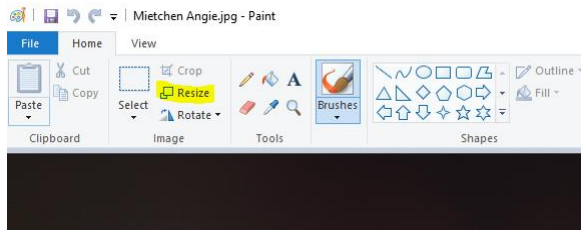


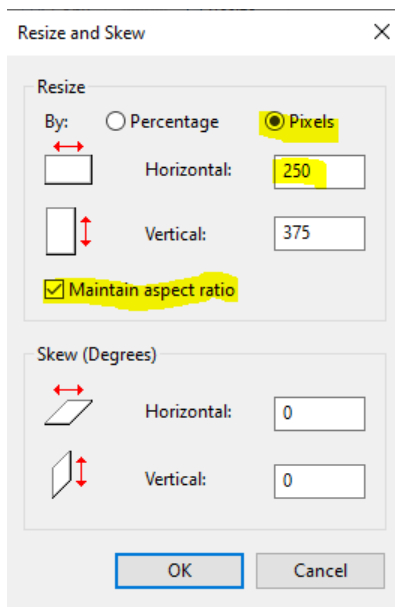
Resizing an Image

By default, photos are very large – over 3 MB. For display on the Web, images do not need to be this big. Large images force a web page to take longer to load. To improve student usability, resize your images appropriately. On a PC, Paint can be used to resize images.

1. Open **Paint**.
2. Click on **File | Open** to locate your image file.
3. From the tool bar, click on **Resize**.



4. In the dialog, click on **Pixels**. For a typical thumbnail photo, enter **250**. Be sure **Maintain aspect ratio** is checked.



5. Click on **Save** icon or **File | Save** to save the resized image.
